King of the Hill Tournament Rules 2011

Every complete division team will play 3 games. Each game will be two 20 minute halves with a 5 minute break. Games are scheduled every 50 minutes. After your game please shake hands with the other team and leave the bench area. Please clean up bench area of any water bottles and deposit in the garbage cans.

Winner is responsible for reporting the score!!!

General Rules

Players must wear full equipment including Helmet, Mouth guards, Arm pads, gloves and shoulder pads

Parents will sit on the opposite side of the field from the players.

Penalties are running time – It is up to the offensive team to get ball into play on a missed shot.

Any fighting or disrespect toward an official will result in expulsion for the remainder of the tournament. NO EXCEPTIONS

Boys and Girls Grades 3-8

The games will be 2, 20 minute running time halves with a 5 minute intermission. A horn will signal the beginning and end of the game.

No timeouts, Officials may use their discretion to extend a game in the event of an injury no longer than 2 minutes. That official will keep extended time

Penalties will be called on the field and the coaches shall keep the time of penalty.

Penalty time runs so it is up to the coaches to make sure a ball is put into play as quickly as possible if you are man up.

Time will be kept at tournament headquarters.

A single long blast will signify the beginning of each game.

A Single long blast will signify the end of the first half.

A single long blast will signify the start of the second half.

Two short blasts will signify 2 minutes left in the game

A long last blast will signal end of the game

No 10 second clearing rule

Keep it in the box for the team ahead last two minutes

Face-offs except when team is down by 5 goals. Ball is given to losing team at midfield regardless of which team scored.

A win is 2 points; tie is one point, 0 for a loss

In the event of a tie for the top 2 teams the tiebreaker will be goals allowed then goals scored

Winning coach to report scores to tournament headquarters at tent

Nassau County PAL Rules Apply

Boys Specific Rules:

No long poles in age groups under 5th grade.

No one handed checks.

No man ball, you must play the ball.

Boys 2nd grade rules:

1) 8 V 8 including the goalie – 2 Attack, 3 Middies, 2 Defense, 1 Goalie

2) Absolutely no hitting allowed.

3) Penalties will be served as a fast break (offender must leave the field and serve full time of penalty even if the other team scores a goal).

4) Max 4 goals from any one player in a game.

5) 4 goal rule, free possession from midfield, 2 passes in the box for winning team.

6) 1 coach allowed on the field for directions, but they cannot hold up play or be in the box to direct players.

7) Parents shall cheer from the opposite side of the field from the players.

8) Have fun and respect the game!
